



Introducing our very own budgeting queen...

My name is **Kim** and I am the **Governance** Officer at MHA. I live in a small, terraced house with my husband and two children, aged 5 & 8.

Lused to find the idea of budgeting really boring. I would spend away and then panic halfway through the month.

I watched some great videos on YouTube about different approaches to budgeting, found a pre-made budget sheet* online and after a bit of practice, I have got the hang of it!

I now plan how I am going to spend my money each month before I get paid. It gives me a licence to spend guilt-free - I know if I allocate £20 to takeaways, I can spend all that money because it's in my budget!

I thought I was rubbish at saving because I was always running out of money. Doing a budget made me realise that saving money is a habit and a mindset - even saving 50p a month is a great start.

I started using the 'Help to Save' scheme while I was claiming Universal Credit, allowing the Government to top up my savings by 50%, over 4 years.

Wearing a woolly jumper or cwtchy blanket in front of the TV is sensible in the current climate, but our homes should be able to keep us from getting cold.

According to experts, over half our energy spend goes on our heating and hot water. Making a few adjustments to your habits, can make a difference to your heating bill.

Turning down your thermostat just one degree lower could make a difference. Set a timer on your thermostat for your heating to come on only when you need it

- Don't heat empty rooms individual radiator thermostats allow you to adjust the temperature in each room
- * Keep doors between adjoining rooms shut
- Run your heating for an hour less each day - even using a little less energy each day adds up to savings over time
- ** Keep the heat in simply closing your blinds or curtains in the evening can stop heat escaping


- ** Don't cover the radiators be sure your curtains don't cover the radiators and don't drape wet clothes over them
- # Bleeding your radiators if your radiators aren't as warm as they should be, bleed them at the start of winter before the temperatures drops
- ** Draught excluders draught proof your window and doors to ensure there are no gaps for heat to escape

Ingredients:

- 200g unsalted butter
- 125g caster sugar
- 300g plain flour
- White chocolate and/or Royal Icing and Christmas sprinkles (optional)

Equipment:

· Baking tray / Large bowl / Greaseproof paper / Rolling pin / Cutters (or use a glass, it's what I did with the circular biscuits in the picture!)

Instructions:

- · Line two large baking trays with greaseproof paper
- In a large bowl mix the butter and sugar until pale and fluffy
- · Add the flour and mix until a dough is formed
- Move the dough from bowl onto a lightly floured surface and roll to 1cm thick
- Use your cutters/glass to shape your biscuits and move onto the tray (leave enough space between the biscuits because they will spread)
- Chill in the fridge for 30 minutes

- Pre heat your oven to 180/160 fan Gas mark 4/3
- · After chilling, transfer to oven and bake for 15 minutes or until lightly golden
- · Cool fully before decorating

Decorating:

- · Melt white chocolate in a heatproof bowl in microwave in bursts of 30 seconds (700 Watt) until melted
- Use a spoon to drizzle over biscuits and then scatter sprinkles
- Or, make up some royal icing with water, add to a piping bag and pipe your design

THE WAY **YOU RENT IS CHANGING**

The Renting Homes Act is the biggest change to housing law in Wales for decades and it is almost here...

You will have previously received a leaflet outlining the changes to the way that you rent your home under the Renting Homes Act and, importantly, what this means for both you and MHA. If you would like another copy of the leaflet, please contact our Customer Services Team.

All tenants will receive a new 'Occupation Contract' which will replace your existing Contract with MHA. The contract will be sent to you by post within 6 months of the Act coming into force. The Contract outlines your rights as a tenant and does not need to be signed and returned to MHA.

The changes that are coming into force will positively affect how you rent your home, and we wish to reassure you we are here to support you and there is nothing for you to worry about.
