# Rising cost of living support

### Discretionary Assistance Fund

Emergency Assistance Payment (EAP)

A grant to help pay for essential costs, such as food, gas, electricity, clothing, or emergency travel if you:

- Experiencing extreme financial hardship.
- · Lost your job.
- Applied for benefits and are waiting for your first payment.

You cannot use it to pay for ongoing bills that you cannot afford to pay.

You can claim 3 EAP's in a 12-month period.

#### **Fuel Bank Foundation**

If you are struggling and use a prepayment meter, you are eligible for support in the form of a voucher:

- You are eligible for £30 Fuel vouchers
- Clients are eligible for 1 voucher in 10 days.
- Clients are eligible for a maximum of 3 vouchers in a 6-month period.
